How many words can you think of that start with Harry Hat Man's sound? Here is a short list to get you started. If your child isn't ready to share words yet, then you can say a word and have your child repeat the word. You can also ask your child to guess what you are describing. For example if you are thinking of the word horse, you can give clues such as, "This is an animal that makes the sound, neigh." When using clues, it will be easiest for your child if you use words and experiences they are familiar with.
